Re: Expired Public Health Emergency for COVID-19

The Public Health Emergency (PHE) due to COVID-19 is scheduled to expire Thursday, May 11, 2023. The expiration of this PHE brings about many changes to our community just as the beginning of the pandemic.

The changes that we greatly welcome and celebrate will be **effective Friday, May 12, 2023:**

Families/Guests

- Screening questions and temperature checks for COVID symptoms are no longer required.
- We continue to require you sign in/out and receive a visitor badge.
- Masks worn throughout the community are no longer strongly encouraged.

Employees

- Screening and temperature checks are no longer required.
- You do not have to sign-in at the kiosks.
- Masks are no longer required.
- Vaccines/Medical/Religious Exemptions are no longer required for employment within our organization.

All (Residents/Families/Employees)

- The Federal regulation, which required notification to residents, resident representatives, families and employees of any single new confirmed COVID-19 infection in the CHR and RC by 5:00 pm the following day is no longer required.

The relaxation of these requirements will only continue to help our community reach the point of stabilization that we all need and desire. We appreciate everyone's patience, support and understanding over the past 38 months and we look forward to seeing all your smiling faces again throughout our community!
